


In the case of a touch screen failure you can use a mouse to disable the touch screen on the X20 to function with mouse only




Start by selecting the start button on the bottom left corner




Select the control panel




Find and select the administrative tools




Find and select the computer management




Find and select the device manager




Find the human interface devices and touch on the plus sign to expand




Once you have expanded the human interface devices double click on the penmount USB to open




Once in the penmount USB utility hit the drop down box at the bottom using the arrow at the right hand side of highlighted box.
